### **Read the Gospels from cover to cover...**

Listen as Jesus speaks to the person in the story; then stop the movie and insert a fresh scene, this time including yourself. Tell him how you feel, what you're thinking, why you're angry or sad, what you're frightened of...

When you've said your piece, don't rush on or run away. Pause; wait; slow down; be quiet; and listen. Even to hear the silence, and to know that Jesus is there in it, is more than worth the effort; but you may hear something else as well.

And when you do, remember the wise words of Jesus' mother Mary to the servants in John 2:5: 'Whatever he says to you, do it.'
