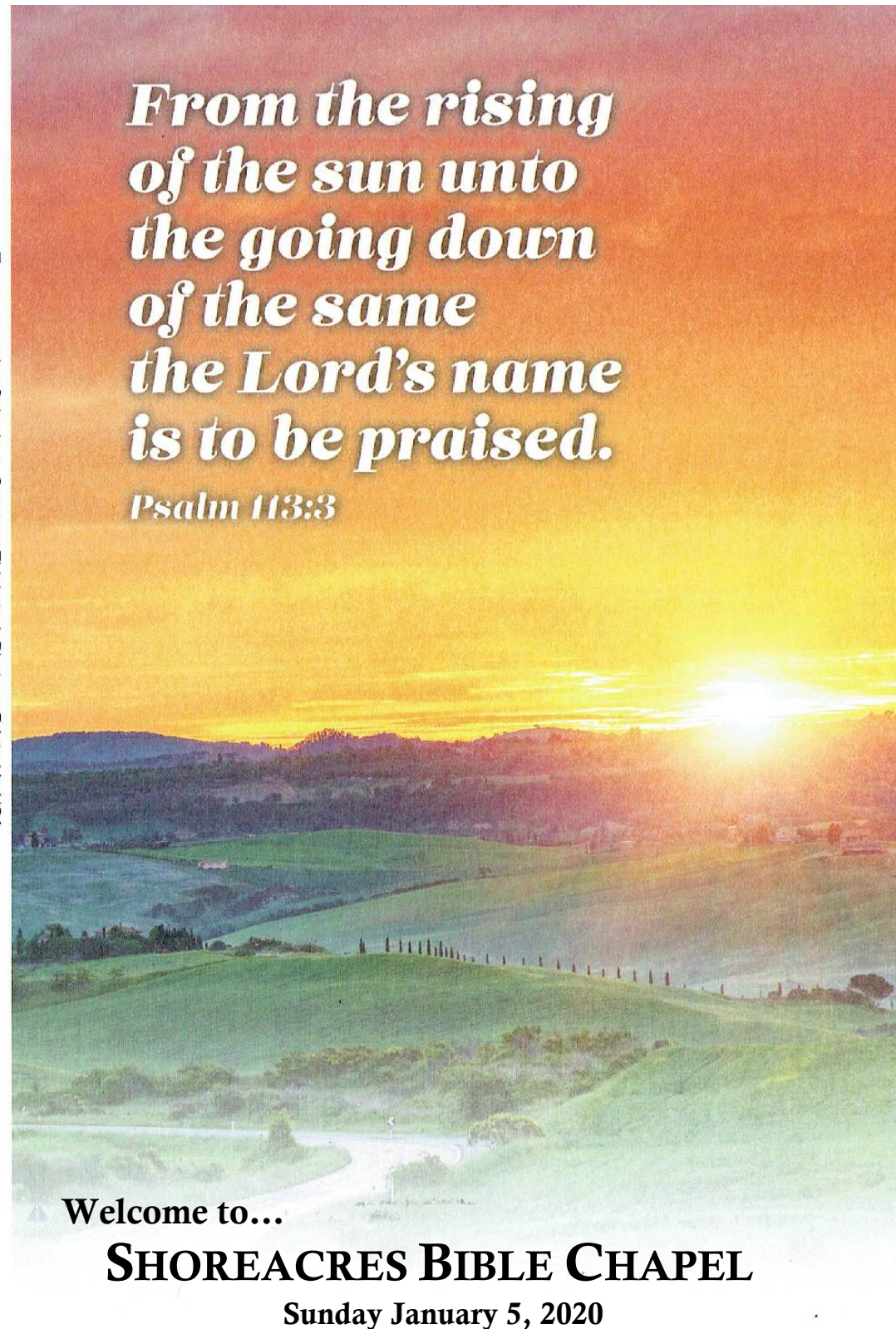
I initially was going to try to move her into better quarters, as there is a nicer retirement home on the other wing, but decided against it after observing her behavior.

She is in the Long Term Care section that has a pass code to enter. My mum is free to leave with guests, but you have to sign in. And she doesn't know the pass code. I can't tell her.
