The nurses and PSWs love her already as she cheers up the other people, and joins in with the sing song sessions etc... and she helps clean up in the cafeteria. So she gets the pleasure of spending time with all the other people there.

I initially was going to try to move her into better quarters, as there is a nicer retirement home on the other wing, but decided against it after observing her behavior.

Please come and visit her. It's called Orchard Terrace, and it's on Highway 8 and Glover Rd.From the QEW, you take Fruitland Rd to the end, and turn left at Highway 8. It's about a kilometer down on the right side.

She is in the Long Term Care section that has a pass code to enter. My mum is free to leave with guests, but you have to sign in. And she doesn't know the pass code. I can't tell her. Philip
