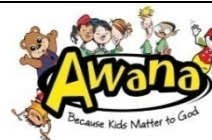
This month we will be showing a film called the Genesis History.


